RE

- Research Judaism and discuss the question—How special is their relationship with God?
- 2. Research Islam and the fifth pillar of their religion—Hajj (pilgrimage). What happens during Hajj?

Science

This term, Year 2 will be researching significant individuals within STEM and recapping previous units of learning.

- 1. Research a famous scientist and create a fact file or poster about the impact they have had within STEM.
- 2. Have a go at completing a science experiment!

PSHE

- Draw and label a picture about your family — what makes your family special? How are families different?
