1. Research Judaism and discuss the question—How special is their relationship with God?
2. Research Islam and the fifth pillar of their religion—Hajj (pilgrimage). What happens during Hajj?

Science

This term, Year 2 will be researching significant individuals within STEM and recapping previous units of learning.

1. Research a famous scientist and create a fact file or poster about the impact they have had within STEM.
2. Have a go at completing a science experiment!

PSHE

4. Can you help your adult with the cooking/baking? What did you weigh? How long did you cook the food? Keep a diary!

1. Can you write a poem about your favourite book using the correct features.
