Uniform Policy 2023-24



<u>Rationale</u>

The primary aim of our Uniform policy is to ensure that parents/carers have a clarity and understanding of the expectations of the school. In maintaining our policy we aim for our pupils to feel a sense of pride and community within the school and among their peers.

What are the aims of the policy?

- Have clear expectations and equity among all pupils
- Promote the ethos of the school
- Provide a sense of belonging and identity
- Set an appropriate tone for our pupils education

<u>Uniform</u>

All children should wear the correct school uniform. The following constitutes Civitas Academy uniform:

- Grey skirt/ pinafore/ trousers/shorts
- School jumper/ cardigan
- White shirt/ polo shirt
- Black shoes of an appropriate height (no open-toed shoes or sandals)
- Green gingham summer dresses in the summer term
- Where socks or tights are visible, they should be a neutral, plain colour which blends with the uniform e.g. black, grey or white.
- Hats should not be worn inside the building (religious headwear is permitted).
- Hair should be neat in appearance without extreme of length or style. Hair should be natural in colour. It must be no shorter than a Grade 2 and without steps, lines or patterns. For reasons of health and safety, long hair must be tied back.

<u>PE Kit</u>

- Black shorts/track suit bottoms
- School house PE T-shirt or house coloured PE T-shirt/plain white t-shirt
- School or plain black hoodie
- Trainers

Jewellery and Make-up

The children should not wear jewellery or make-up in school. Plain stud earrings are permitted for children with pierced ears. Please note that earrings are not permitted for P.E.
